OUR STUDY POINTS FOR THIS LESSON	<p><b>HEALING SCRIPTURES (FROM HOLMAN CHRISTIAN STANDARD BIBLE)</b></p> <p><b>Exodus 4:11-12</b>  11 Yahweh said to him, “Who made the human mouth? Who makes him mute or deaf, seeing or blind? Is it not I, Yahweh?  12 Now go! I will help<sup>a</sup> you speak and I will teach you what to say.”</p> <p><b>Joshua 1:8</b>  This book of instruction must not depart from your mouth; you are to recite<sup>a</sup> it day and night so that you may carefully observe everything written in it. For then you will prosper and succeed in whatever you do.</p> <p><b>Job 8:21</b>  He will yet fill your mouth with laughter and your lips with a shout of joy.</p> <p><b>Job 16:5</b>  Instead, I would encourage you with my mouth, and the consolation from my lips would bring relief.</p> <p><b>Job 32:20</b>  I must speak so that I can find relief; I must open my lips and respond.</p> <p><b>Proverbs 10:11</b>  The mouth of the righteous is a fountain of life, but the mouth of the wicked conceals violence.</p> <p><b>Proverbs 12:6</b>  The words of the wicked are a deadly ambush, but the speech of the upright rescues them.</p> <p><b>Proverbs 12:14</b>  A man will be satisfied with good by the words of his mouth, and the work of a man’s hands will reward him.</p>



<p>OUR STUDY POINTS FOR THIS LESSON</p>	<p><b>HEALING SCRIPTURES</b> (FROM <i>HOLMAN CHRISTIAN STANDARD BIBLE</i>)</p> <p><b>Psalm 21:2-4</b>  2 You have given him his heart’s desire and have not denied the request of his lips.  3 For You meet him with rich blessings; You place a crown of pure gold on his head.  4 He asked You for life, and You gave it to him — length of days forever and ever.</p> <p><b>Psalm 34:1</b>  I will praise the Lord at all times; His praise will always be on my lips.</p> <p><b>Psalm 63:3</b>  My lips will glorify You because Your faithful love is better than life.</p> <p><b>Psalm 71:23</b>  My lips will shout for joy when I sing praise to You because You have redeemed me.</p> <p><b>Proverbs 10:19</b>  When there are many words, sin is unavoidable, but the one who controls his lips is wise.</p> <p><b>Proverbs 12:18</b>  There is one who speaks rashly, like a piercing sword; but the tongue of the wise brings healing.</p> <p><b>Proverbs 12:19</b>  Truthful lips endure forever, but a lying tongue, only a moment.</p> <p><b>Proverbs 14:3</b>  The proud speech of a fool brings a rod of discipline,<sup>[a]</sup> but the lips of the wise protect them.</p> <p><b>Proverbs 15:2</b>  The tongue of the wise makes knowledge attractive, but the mouth of fools blurts out foolishness.</p> <p><b>Proverbs 15:4</b>  The tongue that heals is a tree of life, but a devious tongue<sup>[a]</sup> breaks the spirit.</p> <p><b>Proverbs 16:23</b>  A wise heart instructs its mouth and increases learning with its speech.<sup>[a]</sup></p> <p><b>Proverbs 18:20</b>  From the fruit of his mouth a man’s stomach is satisfied; he is filled with the product of his lips.</p>
